Dear Parents:

The No Child Left Behind Act requires that we share with you the results of our district's progress in meeting the Title III Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAO) for English Language Learners. Districts across the state of Colorado are evaluated annually on three objectives:

1. The percentage of students who make progress in learning English. Target 60%
2. The percentage of students who become proficient in English. Target 25%
3. Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for English Language Learners based on student test participation, graduation, and achievement in reading and math.

During the 2008-2009 school year Weld Re3J School district met two of the three state set targets for AMAO's for English Language Learners. Title III funded districts must meet all three objectives in order to meet the Title III Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives. The district achieved 55% on the first Target, 29 % on the second target and did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) the third target.
